

FACULTY OF PHYSIOTHERAPY SGT UNIVERSITY OUTREACH CAMP DETAILS

As a part of Academic Social Responsibility, the Clinical Extension Services team of Faculty of Physiotherapy regularly conduct Free Health Screening and Physiotherapy camp in villages around the SGT University campus.

Such extension activities are conducted by the faculty for the benefit of society.

We have been a part of outreach programmes conducted by SGT University at village Budhera and Sultanpur. Regular camps, Visits, door to door health survey are organized by the team of health professional from SGT Hospital. A team of physiotherapists which includes staff and students assess, educate and treat patients who require Physiotherapy during the visits. The camps are categorised as screening, diagnosis and referral camps, outreach camps, awareness camps, etc.

People who attend the camp are screened and treated as required for Orthopaedic, Neurological or Cardiopulmonary health related issues. If required patients are advised to continue further treatment in the Physiotherapy OPD of SGT Hospital.

All the community activities are conducted as part of initiative by SGT University collaborating with Faculty of Physiotherapy. Nukkad Natak and Role play are used as medium to spread awareness about importance of health

REPORT ON OUTREACH PROGRAMME TO VILLAGE BUDHERA AND SULTANPUR

Faculty of Physiotherapy has been the part of outreach programme conducted by SGT University at different level in different villages. We have been the part of Budhera project since 2015. Physiotherapy has also started visiting Sultanpur village, which was started by SGT University in March, 2017.

In Budhera project, during the past two and half years we have been conducting health camps on every Monday and Friday from 9.30 am to 12.30 pm. In these camps we assess and treat patients. Additionally if there is a need, we visit patients' home and treat them there. Somehow if patient needs further investigation, then we refer patients to the SGT hospital. During these years we have also conducted a house to house health survey by medical team consisting medical, dental, nursing and Physiotherapy staff and students.

We also conduct some meetings with the villagers from time to time. We have taken some lectures on women health, musculoskeletal health issues, ergonomics etc.

A team of physiotherapists which includes staff and students regularly visits the Sultanpur village wherein they assess, educate and treat patients who require Physiotherapy.
